people about nonsense for hours as the day goes by, but with you it's so hard for me to speak, I can barely say the word 'Hashem', help me speak to you'.

There was once a Breslever Chusid who had nothing, literally nothing, and he used to tell everyone, "Hashem is so good to me, Hashem gives me only good".
