The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Chanukah will begin next week on Sunday night. Prepare a Menorah for you and for your children. Make arrangements with your job that they should let you go home to light the Menorah with your children. We must be home on time. Chanukah is a time that a father plants holiness with Emunah in his children. If small children are kept up late, they will get tired and they won't be able to join along. But if we will be home on time around 6:00, then we can have a nice time with the kids. Sing, dance, and speak about the miracles that Hashem does with us.

The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

The Bnei Yissaschar asked, what is the reason why the Shevatim threw Yosef into the pit and then they went ahead and ate bread and had a party? This is stange to understand. He answered with something he heard from his Rebbe, that a person

should eat something before he comes home after work. This is to make sure he doesn't come home hungry and nervous so he loses his control and starts eating up his wife's intestines. In Breslev we have a minhag to make Kiddush before we come home on Shabbos morning. Many women need extra sleep on Shabbos morning to rest up from the busy weekday mornings. Some people are strict not to make Kiddush before coming home but then their behaviour at home is with nerves. When we come home and there is no supper, we can take something small to eat. We must be very careful to speak nicely to our wife. Mohorosh said that on Chanukah the Halacha is if we only have one candle either for Shabbos or for Chanukah, Shabbos comes first in order for there to be Shalom Bayis. Chanukah is a Yom Tov for me to be home with my family. The Chanukah gift will be speaking nicely to them and spending time with them. This is the nicest thing to give to our children.

Right now we are preparing and setting up the Menorah. We are going to be lighting the holy Chanukah Menorah. Whatever type of Menorah that we have with our custom, whether it's with candles or oil, or with cotton wicks and your own wicks, all these things are very nice but we must remember the actual Mitzvah itself. Many times people feel like they are very far from the Mitzvah, but when we light the Menorah we light up all the worlds. You are lighting up your soul.
