Friday Night and say Shulem Aleichem, we are actually greeting real Malachim. Mohorosh used to bend his head by Borchini Leshulem to have these Malachim Bentch him. These Malachim come to every Yiddishe home, not just to the Tzadikim but to every simple Yid. Mohorosh said that the Malachim that come, are the Malachim that were created from all the Mitzvos that we did throughout the week.

The holy Chachamim said in (Tana Dvei

Eliyahu 1), "Derech Eretz Kodmah LaTorah". Without it there is no Yiddishkeit, there is no Torah, no Parsha, only with Derech Eretz! This is dependent only on the children, we must demand from the children strong Derech Eretz. We must be very very strict about the kids having Derech Eretz. Strict doesn't mean being harsh to the children, but it means that we have to be very very strong about demanding Derech Eretz from the kids.

The Four Malachim

Today we are finishing Meseches Bava Basra, and we will be starting Meseches Sanhedrin. I am begging you to also start learning everyday a Blatt Gemorah. If we learn a Blatt Gemorah, we will be surrounded with the Shechina Hakedosha. Mohorosh said that Gemorah is the initials of the four Malachim - Gavriel, Michoel, Refael, and Uriel. When we learn Gemorah we come close to these four Malachim, and we have a higher level of protection from above.
