The first pasuk in Parshas Vayigash explains how a person needs to be together with Hashem and we can not give any advice to ourselves on our own. This is what the Holy Rebbe taught us that when a person sees that he keeps on falling and

falling, he must tell Hashem, "Hashem what should I do?" You are in me! You must help me! When a child falls and cries it's a good sign, if the child doesn't cry it's not a good sign. When a person does Aveiros and he cries that he doesn't want to do it and he says it over and over again, this is a good thing. If we fall and we don't cry then it is a bad thing.

No one can do me any harm, and no one can do me any good. Everything is from above. Chazal say in (Chullin 7b) A person can't bang his finger, unless it was decreed from above. Certainly your father, mother, family, and all your problems and difficulties are all from Hashem.

## The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Today is the holy Reb Nosson's Yartzeit. The Rebbe said that without this young man Reb Nosson there would not be a leaf of paper left of mine. Reb Nosson said, that even the biggest Bal Aveira can get Chizuk from the Rebbe. Therefore, the Yetzer Horah puts a lot of pressure on a person not to stay by the Rebbe. This is because when a person is by the Rebbe the Yetzer Horah has no control over you anymore. Even if you are a person who does Aveiros, the Rebbe strengthens you to speak to Hashem and say, Hashem I want to be an honest Jew and be guarded. Reb Nosson said that from such a Rebbe we don't leave! Even if someone would knock me in the head. I won't leave the Rebbe.

The Rebbe said there are two types of people that I have mercy on. One who has not become my student, and the other is one who is my student and does not listen to me. The time will come that you will be lying with your feet towards the door and you will leave this world. Then you will wonder why I didn't come to the Rebbe, or why I didn't listen to the Rebbe? If I would have listened to the Rebbe there wouldn't be a problem in the world that I would not be able to deal with. What does it mean to listen to the Rebbe? We use our lips to speak to Hashem. Hashem, what's going to be with me? When will I do Teshuva? Hashem, when will I be happy? Hashem, when will I not have any questions on you? Hashem when will I have Emunah? Every word that we say to Hashem, this is what we will bring together with us forever.
