### The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

What can we do during these days of Shovavim? We can enjoy Shabbos. Have a nice Shabbos. Make a nice Seuda for Shabbos. Have an Oneg Shabbos. Mohorosh writes many many times in Asher Banachal, that the holy Chachamim said in Medresh Tanchuma at the end of Parshas Bereishis, that enjoying Shabbos is greater than fasting 1,000 fasts. Someone who enjoys Shabbos and appreciates Shabbos, it is greater than 1,000 fast days. We are very fragile

and weak people, and we don't have any strength to fast. The holy Ari said that if a person is Pogem B'bris he must fast 84 fasts. This is only for 1 time, let alone multiple times. Therefore, we don't have the strength to fast, and the Rebbe said we should not fast. What can we do as a remedy? We will take this Chazal and we will enjoy Shabbos. We will eat and drink in honor of The Rebbe said Shabbos. in (Lekutei Mohoran 2:17) that on Shabbos we must be very happy, and eating on Shabbos is complete holiness. When we eat all the 3 meals in honor of Shabbos, this will be our remedy for Shovavim.

Don't look at what happened yesterday, that

Mohorosh asked someone to go buy a tape recorder for him to record the letters on a tape and someone can type it up. Mohorosh took out of his pocket some singles and fives, however this person felt bad to take money from Mohorosh. He told Mohorosh, "It's ok, I have money, Mohorosh doesn't need to give me anything, I will go buy it right away". Mohorosh turned to him with a smile and said, "What is money? Money is round like a wheel, Hashem gives us money to use it for things we need, and if we don't use it, then we are stopping our abundance. We can not be stingy with money. We can not throw money away for nonsense, but for important things, such as your wife needs money for a cleaner, or for new clothes etc., we can not say don't use this money, we need to save it for a later time. This might stop your wealth.
