Why is it that the Torah immediately begins with Pharaoh not knowing Yosef? The holy Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 1:61), The main thing a Yid needs is Emunas Tzadikim. To believe in Tzadikim, and to follow their path. When a Yid believes in a Tzadik and listens to his word, then he has a clear head and peace of mind. He knows how to conduct himself in every situation, whether it's on his own account or dealing with others around him.
