For example, for the letter Aleph, ask for Emunah, say, Hashem, let me feel your presence and remember that you are always with me. Aleph is Emes, beg Hashem to help you only speak with Emes, not lie, and go along the true path. Continue on with all the letters, as Beis is for Bonim, beg Hashem that you shouldn't smack your kids and get nervous at them. Beis is for Bayis, beg Hashem to have a holy home, a mini Beis Hamikdash, and so on.

Reb Burech'l said, "Feigele, this can not be, there is nothing you can do, there must be disagreement with him". (Explained at length in Peulas Hatzadik 21). This is because a Tzadik who has the power to bring Yiden back to Hashem, must have controversy on him, in order for it to be done

with truth, just as the Halacha says that when Moshiach will come, no one will be able to convert because by then they won't be converting out of love for Hashem. (Sourced in Lekutei Moharan 1:228).
