The Rebbe explains the first Pasuk in this week's Parsha (Bereishis 44:18), "Vayigash

Eilav Yehuda", a Yid comes to Hashem, "Vayomer Bi Adoni", and he says, don't be upset with me that I sinned, because "Bi" in me, "Adoni". You should say these words to Hashem, "Hashem, when will I merit to feel you? When will I remember 'Bi Adoni', that you are in me, by me and next to me? Help me not to forget about you, I should remember that everything is you, and no one can help me, or harm me".

Reb Nachman Tulchiner used to dance everyday. If he would remind himself when he got into bed at night that he didn't dance yet, he would get up and do a little dance. This is how important it is to dance in order to sweeten the judgement, as sourced in (Lekutei Moharan 1:10). Even a quiet and shy person who is ashamed to dance in front of others, should

dance at home with his kids. It's a small thing but it energizes a person, it lifts up the whole family, and takes away all the bad judgment. Make it the standard that when you come home, do a little dance with your kids, and the Shechina will rest in your home.

In today's days, it's so easy to do the Mitzvah of Kibud Av V'eim. If you live a little far, you should go visit your parents at least once a month, and if you live nearby, you should definitely go over every week, but if you live in the same city then you should go visit them everyday. Hashem said in (Kiddushin 30b), "Whoever honors his father and his mother it's as if he honors me". The Mitzvah of Kibud Av V'eim is so great it's just like honoring Hashem himself (Sourced in Baba Metzia 32a).
