The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

"Hashem hates me!" Who told you that? Who told you this lie and Lashon Harah about Hashem? Chas Veshalom!! "But I sinned!" So what? You can do Teshuva! Ask Hashem to forgive you. "Yeh but lately I'm very far from Yiddishkeit..., I watch bad stuff and haven't put on Tefilin". So come and put on Tefilin! Come put on Tefilin!! Someone once came to Mohorosh to ask for a Tikkun for his sins. Mohorosh asked him if he put Tefilin on already, and he said No. Mohorosh gave him his own Tefilin and said first put it on then we'll talk.
