The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Be cautious of jokesters who make fun of Tzadikim. Nothing is worse than having jokester friends. Shlomo Hamelech said in (Mishlei 17:12), Rather meet up with a bear, than a fool, a jokester, who makes fun of others. Because mockery is the Avi Avos Hatumah. There is no other Tumah that obstructs Hashem like the Tumah of mockery. Guard yourself from jokesters and specifically from jokesters that call themselves Breslever Chassidim.

Lack of Interest

The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Hashem told Moshe to tell Ahron to light the Menorah. Rashi asks, what is the connection between the Parsha of the Menorah to the Parshas HaNasiem? The answer is that Ahron had a lack of interest, even though he was going into the Kodesh Hakadoshim but he was still broken. He thought does Hashem need me or not? I was not needed, the Nasiem were the ones who were taken. This is a great Chizuk, as we see the Rebbe's words that he heard from Tzadikim,

that everyone goes through a lack of interest. The Rebbe said in (Lekutei Mohoran 2:48), "When a person starts serving Hashem it happens that he has a lack of interest, or other thoughts that the Yetzer Horah brings into a person's mind if he is needed or not, but a Tzadik also has discouraging thoughts". Hashem said don't be distraught, you just light the Menorah, because Hashem has great pleasure from every action a Yid does, even though you don't feel worthy.

Mohorosh relates that an extremely wealthy man once came to the holy Chofetz Chaim and asked, "What does it mean that Hashem can make someone rich, and make someone poor, I have money in banks all over the world, how can it be that I can a become poor man?". The Chofetz Chaim could not even look at him after asking such a question on Hashem. The Chofetz Chaim looked down and said, "Hashem can't take away your money from the Swiss banks, the Holland Banks, or other banks all at one time, however, Hashem can take you away from all the banks in one second. The man got

seriously shaken up from these words of a Tzadik. People think that if I am successful in Real Estate, I must be cautious that Real Estate will crash so I will also invest in Amazon, but might also go bust Amazon government will stop Amazon, then I'll also set up chests of Gold, it might be that Gold will go up etc.. So how can I become a poor man in one second? The man did Teshuva and asked the Chofetz Chaim where he could give his money to Tzedakah. The Chofetz Chaim now looked up at him and said, now you are asking a smart question! You can help Yeshivos Talmud Torahs bring Torah to Yiddishe children.
