You can't imagine what Torah does to a person. Even a person who is R"L in the lowest of the lowest, if he takes upon himself to learn Torah every day - The Torah will take him out of all his Aveiros, and Hashem will forgive him for his Aveiros. Chazal said in (Yerushalmi Rosh Hashanah 4:8), "When a person takes upon himself to accept the Torah", this means he takes upon himself to learn every day the holy Torah then Hashem says, that "I will calculate it as if you have never sinned". To learn every day a Perek Mishnayos, this will cleanse you and take away all your blemishes.

The holy Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 1:249), "Where does a person get strength in his heart from, and not be afraid of anyone or anything? It only depends on his own heart, and without any fear goes into the middle of the fight". We constantly find ourselves in a fight to serve Hashem. Therefore we need to have a Tzadik who can guide us, as the Rebbe continues to learn the Mishna in (Avos 4), Who is strong? Someone who can win over his bad desires.
