The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

"Yivarechicha Hashem Veyishmirecha", Hashem should bless you and guard you. The Medresh says in (Bamidbar Rabah 11:5) this means, Hashem should Bentch you with money, and guard you from any damage (12:3). The holy Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 1:68), the truth is that every Yid should have money, however there is one bad trait that can take it away and that is "anger". Anger and money come from the same place. When we get angry, we lose our money. This is the meaning of Hashem gives us money but Hashem must guard you from the damages that come from anger. If we are cautious with our anger then we will have a lot of money.
