# The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

When the spies returned from Eretz Yisrael, they said, "there we saw the fallen ones." Rashi explains that "the fallen ones" were the children of those Malachim. When the Meraglim saw these fallen ones and understood who they were, they concluded that if angels could not overcome

the spiritual dangers of the physical world, then surely the Jewish People - mere humans wouldn't be able to maintain their holiness in a world of Gashmiyus, either. However, they had underestimated the power of a Yiddishe neshama. A person can endure on this world; man is far stronger and far greater than any angel. And if he does make a mistake and sins, he can always do Teshuva and Hashem will forgive him. The Meraglim's mistakes had drastic repercussions which we still feel the effects of today. We must be sure not to repeat those mistakes! Let us open our eyes to Hashem's constant Hashgacha and to our own abilities, and with that, we will Be'ezras Hashem be Zoche to return to Eretz Yisrael for good.
