This week we have a big Shabbos, Shabbos Parshas Shekalim, and Shabbos Mevorchim Adar Beis. The holy Tzadik Reb Pinchas Koritzer said that he can't wait until the four Parshios would come so he can see Hashem. These days are such a tremendous time for

us to renew ourselves, and merit to reach great levels to see Hashem. Parshas Shekalim states that everyone needs to bring a half Shekel. Chazal said that Moshe Rabbeinu didn't understand the whole concept of bringing a half Shekel. What is so difficult to understand to bring a half Shekel? This was after the sin of the Golden Calf, and Klal Yisrael had fallen in the worst Aveiros and therefore Moshe couldn't understand how with this small coin, your soul would be forgiven? Hashem showed Moshe from under his holy throne, with this actual coin, when a Yid gives even a small coin to Tzedaka, or he does even the smallest thing, this goes straight up to the Keisei Hakavod.
