The holy days of Purim are coming, when we reach the level of 'Ad DeLo Yoda, bein Arur Haman L'Baruch Mordechai'. Tzadikim explain this to mean that it's a level of Olam Habah, where everything is good. On Purim a great holiness is brought down from Olam Habah. We don't differentiate between good or bad, we know and believe that everything is from Hashem. This is something that the Rebbe instills in us the entire year, that we should have a strong Emunah, that everything is for the good and is done with a calculation.
