Do you know why we fast on Tanis Esther? The Shulchan Aruch says that we fast to remind and show us that when there is a difficulty, there is only one option, to fast and scream to Hashem. This is what Mordechai and Esther did. We also have the custom to give Machatzis Hashekel on Tanis Esther, as the Rebbe said that through giving Shekalim you will be saved from the Yetzer Horah. Hashem should help us get saved from the Yetzer Horah.

must always look for the wonders in every single thing. This means that if someone puts his head to it, he will realize that everything that happens are signs from Hashem for him to come close to him. This is the reason for Hashem calling out to every Yid, and if we focus on it, then Hashem will continue speaking to us and have us become closer to him.
