The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

This Shabbos will be Parshas Parah, a very big Shabbos. We will be cleaned of Tumas Meis. The Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 1:242), What is Tumas Meis? Thinking about Shmutz, thinking about Aveiros, watching movies, videos etc. This is the worst impurity, this is Tumas Meis, we become dead, we tear ourselves away from Hashem. We need to come to the Kohen Gadol, to the Tzadikim and have them spray us with pure well water, and with their advice they will purify us.

Liberate Our Minds

The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Parshas Vayakhel, a Parsha that is almost exclusively dedicated to the building of the mishkan, unexpectedly begins with two Pesukim about keeping Shabbos. Shabbos is more than just a day of rest. The Rebbe says (Likutei Moharan 2:17) that during the week, our minds are in a state of Galus. Occupied as we are by the pressures of day-to-day living, it is easy to lose our focus. We tend to forget that Hashem is the only One in control and attribute power to mere humans, thinking that they can help us and/or harm us. Shabbos offers not just a break from the mundane, but also the opportunity to liberate our minds from shackles of mistaken thinking. Shabbos takes our minds out of galus.

Go Hafutza, you can't imagine how important it is to Hashem to help bring people back to Hashem. We hear such horrible stories of people who commit suicide out of depression, out of a sense of loss, and this is only because they are lacking Emunah. They don't know why they are alive, for who we live for, they roam around with questions and complaints, 'Why do I need to suffer? Why do I have to go through all this?' They don't know anything about Emunah in Hashem. Go out of your comfort zone and do something for someone else. Give someone a card, a Gilyon, a CD, a Sefer, a Kuntris, and you will save a Jewish life.
