### The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Parshas Behar begins with Hashem telling Moshe to tell Kal Yisrael that when they come into Eretz Yisrael, they should work the fields for six years, but the seventh year must be Shabbos, not to work the entire year. Then it says that, "If you would come and ask what will

we eat in the seventh year?", the Pasuk says, "You will be blessed in the sixth year for the sixth year, seventh year, and for the beginning of the following year. The holy Noam Elimelech asks, why does the Torah have to say, "If you would come and ask"? Why can't it just say that there will be blessings? Reb Elimelech says in the name of Reb Zisha, Hashem created the world where every single person has blessings, food, money and everything a person needs. As soon as we are born Hashem gives us sustenance, but when a person loses his faith in Hashem and has questions, "where will I get my sustenance from?", then he cuts off his assistance and Hashem has to recreate a new creation for this person.

We can not understand the greatness of Tzedaka. Chazal said in (Bava Basra 9a), the Mitzvah of Tzedaka is so great, just as all the Mitzvos in the Torah. The opposite is true as well, if we don't give any Tzedaka it is a very bad thing, as Chazal said (Bava Basra, 10a), if we don't give any Tzedaka it's as if we serve Avodah Zara. It is written in the holy Zohar (Parshas Vayeira 104a), when Hashem loves someone, he sends him a gift - a poor person. When a poor person comes to you and asks you for Tzedaka, you should dance for joy that Hashem is showing you that he loves you.
