### **The Rosh Yeshiva Says:**

The holy Torah says that we should help a poor man, and he should live with you. Reb Nosson writes in (Lekutei Halachos Kiddushin 3:4), We see that there are wealthy individuals who don't want to give Tzedakah. They say that "now it's tough times, I'm also struggling myself, I can't give any Tzedaka". However the truth is that the

wealthy live their life on a higher standard, and on that account they are struggling. Therefore for themselves they can afford these higher standards but for the poor he will only help him if he is dying of hunger. This is why the Pasuk is telling us that your brother should live 'with you'. The same way you allow yourself to live with luxuries, you may allow him to enjoy life as well. This way Hashem will pay you back and you will be blessed with everything you need.

After sitting in the cave for 13 years, while learning and eating bukser and only drinking water, Reb Shimon didn't come out of the cave and went to sleep and rest up, No!, he went to go see what he can do to help people. This is the greatest thing we can do in this world, to help another Yid learn, or to let him know that it's not the end of the world, or have another husband and wife know how to live together. Strengthen yourself, don't look at anyone and go a little Hafutzah.

Shem Tov says, "When one sins with thoughts of immorality, his children will give him much grief, when he sins with immoral speech his wife will bring him anguish, when he does Aveiros in action, those around him will cause him pain". Instead of throwing the blame onto your wife, do Teshuva for all that you have transgressed. If you will repent completely, you will be zoche to what Shlomo Hamelech teaches (Mishlei 16:7). "He who follows in Hashem's ways will see his enemies make peace with him." Chazal say (Bereishis Rabbah 54:1), that this is referring to one's wife. When a person conducts himself the way he should, his wife will assist him and respect him, and they will live in harmony.
