Love The Bad

The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

The Rebbe teaches in (Lekutei Moharan 1:165) on the Pasuk in this week's Parsha "Veahavta Lereacha Kamocha, Ani Hashem",

the simple meaning of the word 'Reacha' is "Your fellow", but it can also mean 'Raah Shelcha', your bad. Hashem tells us, love the bad that happens to you, because of, the way you are. You really deserve harsh punishments, but I am the Baal Harachamim, so I am treating you with tremendous mercy and bringing you smaller difficulties instead. The Pasuk therefore tells us, don't take revenge on those who have wronged you. Rather, love the bad that others have done to you, because the way you are, it could have been a lot worse. Despite what you really deserve, I, Hashem, am treating you with mercy instead.

The Mitzvah of Pesach Sheini came about for the Yiden who were impure. They came to Moshe Rabeinu and complained in (Bamidbar 9:7), "Why were we left out?" They also wanted to do the Mitzvah. Moshe Rabeinu saw their will, and asked Hashem to help them out. When people want to do good, Hashem helps them, as sourced in (Shabbos 104b). This is great Chizuk for us as the Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 2:39), Hashem should have mercy on us not to lose our willpower, and beg Hashem that I also want to be a Tzadik and have pure thoughts.
