Brought To The Tzadik

The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

One can only give Tzedaka if he has money to give. How can a person be Mechazek others if he is also dispirited and in desperate need of encouragement? The solution to this lies in this

week's Parsha: If a person is "poor" - he is disheartened and thinks he is worthless, he must be brought to the Tzadik, the Tzadik will then find the good in him and remind him of how valuable he is. This encouragement will give him strength to continue despite his hardships, and enable him to give chizuk, as well. That is why it is so important to have a connection to a Tzadik. Our Tzadikim reveal the enormous Kochos that lie dormant inside us and give us the ability to remain strong and strengthen others, no matter what hardships we endure.
