Now that we have completed half of Shas, and we are now starting Baba Kama, it seems so difficult to understand all the different details, yet the Rebbe said to say the words and you will come to understand. When we will come to Shamayim we will be asked if we ever went through all of Torah? People think it's so far and not for me. We need to take on the

Rebbes Derech Halimud and no one even has to know about it. I will know for myself that not just the Ruv is a Shas Yid, but I am a Shas Yid. This makes a person very happy.

I beg you dearly, be happy. When a person is happy he gets to the highest place. Mohorosh said in the name of the holy Tzadik Reb Moshe Leib Sasover, the holy Chachamim said in (Baba Metziah 59a), "All doors are locked except the door of tears". The Tzadik said, even the doors of tears don't get locked, but there are still doors to find. Not everyone can cry, and some can't cry so easily. However, happiness has no doors, we don't need to wait for someone to open, or close it. Only immediately when a person is happy then he is by Hashem himself.

Chazal said in (Eruvin 13b), "It would have been better for a person not to have been born, however now since we have been created already we should make sure to do as many Mitzvos and Maasim Tovim as we can". Therefore we must always thank Hashem that we were created. Reb Nosson said, when Hashem sees how we thank and praise him, Hashem tells the Malachim, "Look at this Yid, he has nothing and he is thanking me, I will show him what good really means". On the contrary as well, when Hashem hears how someone doesn't stop complaining, Hashem says, I will show him what bad really means.

The more a person recognizes Emunah, the healthier his soul is. The Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 2:5), There are diseases that don't have a cure, and this comes from a lack of faith. We literally see it today with many sicknesses of the soul. People have many imaginations or fears and they simply can't live. This all comes from a lack of faith. Someone who constantly strengthens his Emunah, his soul becomes healthy.
