The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

Go to Shul first thing in the morning. Don't go anywhere and don't speak with anyone until you finish Davening. Don't miss even one Tefillah, be Moser Nefesh to come to Shul, because the same way that you conduct yourself, even if you have very young children, that is the same way your children will follow in your ways. The Rebbe said in (Sefer Hamidos Ois Tefillah 36), One who has a Shul in his town and he doesn't go to Daven there, then his children will be lost in exile. This is because children see that if their father doesn't go to Shul, then they too will also be careless about it R"L. The same is true if you talk by Davening, then your children won't Daven at all. Keep the Shul holy, don't do any business there, come to Shul with respect and honor, wrap your Tallis around you and say "Hashem give me Ehrlicher children and grandchildren who will live with you and go in the path of Torah.
