Yochai said, I wonder what the argument is, because I say that they were both created together like a pot with its cover. Mohorosh explains that the main purpose of a person in this world is to serve Hashem both spiritually and physically. When a Yid wants to be Ehrlich he doesn't need to throw away the physical, on the contrary, we can serve Hashem in a physical way too, as long as we conduct ourselves as Halacha permits, and just as Hashem said.
