As the Rebbe said in (Chayei Moharan 403), "Those who come to him for Rosh Hashanah, must be happy for the entire year". Thirdly, don't get carried away with all the surroundings, the main thing is to come to Uman. Where you will Daven and where you will stay is not the main part.
