#### The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

What should we do that Breselv is shamed? What could we do that Lashon Horah is spoken about the Rebbe and his Talmidim? This causes people to be afraid of Breslev. It causes people to get worried that their children have connections to Breslev. This is the way it needs to be, there needs to be nonsense spoken about Tzadikim. On every true Tzadik silly things are said. Chazal said in (Yerushalmi Brochos 2:8), "In every generation there are fools", all Tzadim have been spit on and disputed. Every newcomer that wants to come to the Rebbe for Rosh Hashanah in Uman must go through this test. Otherwise we can not merit to receive all the good from the Rebbe.

Parshas Netzavim begins with the heads of Klal Yisrael gathering together. The holy Rebbe said in (Lekutei Moharan 1:211), that we can't have pure thoughts, a clear mind, without being connected to Tzadikim, and through these pure thoughts we can sweeten all judgment. Therefore, we travel to Tzadikim for Rosh Hashanah. On Rosh Hashanah it is written all the judgment for the upcoming year, and if we are by the Tzadik for Rosh Hashanah, then we get to have pure thoughts and sweeten the judgment for the upcoming year. When we merit to be by a Tzadik for Rosh Hashanah, three "Heads" come together, everyone comes with his "Head", to the Tzadik who is the "Head" of Klal Yisrael, for the "Head" of the year.

Purity Of The Mind

#### The Rosh Yeshiva Says:

The Rebbe says in (Lekutei Moharan 1:211), Why do we travel to a Tzadik for Rosh Hashanah? Because the only way to get a sweetened judgment is by having pure thoughts. Everything that a person goes through, all his problems and difficulties, revolves around the type of thoughts he has. When a person thinks about Hashem and he is connected to Hashem, there are no problems. He feels Hashem wherever he goes and wherever he finds himself. If he's at home and his wife needs his help, he's connected to Hashem. If he is in Beis Medresh, or at work, or at his parents, or at his in-laws, or on the street, it all revolves around the purity of his mind, and a person can not have a pure mind without being connected to a Tzadik.
